Baptism

Our baptism, like that of Jesus, was both a gift and a commission. In bestowing favour upon us, God at the same time calls us to be his servants. On the day of our baptism, we are commissioned as servants of God, after the example of Jesus. As God endowed Jesus with the Spirit so that he could bring true justice to the nations, at our baptism we were endowed with the same Spirit for the same purpose.

In the power of the Spirit we are called to live in that same just way that Jesus lived. In the words of the first reading, baptism calls us ' *to serve the cause of right*'. That will involve for us, as it did for Jesus, taking care not to '*break the crushed reed, nor quench the wavering flame*'

Those who are crushed for whatever reason, whose flame is barely flickering, are deserving of our greatest care and attention. We show that we really appreciate the gift of our baptism when we support the vulnerable and strengthen the weak in our families and communities.
