St Maximilian Kolbe (1894 - 1941)

A Franciscan priest, Maximilian was arrested in 1941 and sent to Auschwitz. While there he took the place of another prisoner, a man with a family, and was executed in his place. He was canonized by Pope John Paul 11 in 1982.

The gospel reading today tells us that our 'treasure' is not to be found in this world, it is in heaven 'where no thief can reach it and no moth destroy it'. That is our ultimate destination and we get there by following the Way laid out for us by Jesus.
