Feast Days

Oct 15th

St Teresa of Avila (1515-1582)

Teresa entered the Carmelites espite strong opposition from her father. Teresa was a woman for others. Though a contemplative, she spent much of her time and energy seeking to reform herself and the Carmelites. She founded half a dozen new monasteries in Spain.

Oct 17th

St Ignatius of Antioch

St Ignatius, bishop of **Antioch** (Turkey) died a martyr in **Rome in 107.** He urged the early Christians to unite around the Eucharest and their local bishop.

Oct 18th

St Luke

He wrote the third Gospel sometime between the year 70 -85. St Luke's Gospel is often referred to as the Gospel of Mercy. Luke emphasizes Jesus' compassion and patience with the sinners and the suffering. His is the Gospel of the poor, as reflected in the stories of The Good Samaritan and The Prodigal Son, only found in St Luke's Gospel.

Gratitude

Today's Gospel tells the story of the cure of the ten lepers. Once healed, nine of the ten lepers cant wait to get back to their families, from which their disease had excluded them. Who would blame them. It was very natural, they were so happy.

However, one of ten, a **Samaritan**, 'turned back' praising God at the top of his voice and when he reached **Jesus** he threw himself at **Jesus**' feet, thanking him. He alone recognized that in his healing he had been blessed by **God**; he alone saw beyond the gift to the giver, **God**. He saw his healing with different eyes to the other nine, with the eyes of faith. **Jesus** says 'No one has come back to give praise to **God**, except this foreigner' He alone of the ten was truly a man of faith in God.

This story encourages us to see all of life with the eyes of faith, recognizing that the many good things, the blessings, that come our way in life have their source in **God**.

The healed leper inspires us to respond in gratitude, to praise and thank God with all our heart.
