# **Feast Days**

Feb: 14<sup>th</sup> SS Cyril & Methodius

These two brothers from **Thessalonica** in **Greece**, lived in the ninth century. They were declared patrons of Europe by **Pope John Paul11** in 1980.

Feb: 14<sup>th</sup> St Valentine

Valentine was a Christian priest in **Rome** who assisted martyrs during the persecution under the **Emperor Claudius 11** 

Feb: 17<sup>th</sup> St Fintan

This seventh century Irish saint is associated with **Co Laois**. He founded a monastery at **Clonenagh**.

## The Beatitudes

Today we hear from **St Luke** reporting on the Beatitudes in the **Sermon on the Mount**. **Luke** highlights four of the eight found in **Matthew's gospel** The Beatitudes are not meant to replace the **Ten Commandments**. Rather, the Beatitudes add dept to our understanding of **God's** law and gives us direction that helps us to find the right path to follow in life.

Does that mean each of us should give away all our possessions and live a life of poverty? Are we to go around with sorrowful faces, all the time? The answer is obviously no!

Through the years and up to our present time there have been saints who lived radical lives, from **St Francis of Assisi** to **Mother Teresa**. By giving up all their possessions, they provide us examples of what it means to live the Beatitudes to the fullest. The Beatitudes wake us up to the fact that our possessions, our gifts and talents, are to be put at the service of others. Warnings are intended to prevent us from following the wrong path, the saints show us the right path.
