Pope Francis has spoken often of our brotherly responsibility towards our fellow human beings, and how our welcome ought to be a response to the Lord's supreme commandment to **love one another** as ourselves. In today's gospel **Jesus** invites the disciples to 'Come and see' where he lives. He welcomes them into his home and they stay with him for the rest of the day. This example of **Jesus** encourages us to be welcoming, and to spend time with others in friendship.
