This Anthony is not **Anthony of Padua**, the Franciscan preacher who lived in the thirteenth century. Today's St Anthony is often refered to as "the father of modern monasticism" He lived a life of solitude but also attracted many others to form communities of hermits.

Week of Prayer for Christian Unity

The annual week of prayer for Christian Unity goes from January 18 to the 25th. The theme for this week's year of prayer is 'you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your strength, and with all your mind; and your neighbour as yourself' (Luke 10:27).

MARK

This year is the year of **Mark** which means the Gospel read on Sundays through the year will be **St Marks Gospel**, starting next weekend. It is noted for its simple and popular style. Mark's Gospel deals with **Galilean** ministry of Jesus, and the events of the last week in **Jerusalem**. Mark makes no reference to the birth of Jesus or to the well known parables such as the **Good Samaritan** or the **Prodical Son**. Action dominates the Gospel throughout and there is a dramatic sense of uegency.

The shortest of the Gospels, it is presumed to be the earliest written account of the life of **Jesus**, within twenty five years of his death and resurrection. It was a primary source of information about the ministry of **Jesus**. The other Gospel writers relied heavily on Mark's account of the life and teaching of Jesus.

The late actor, **Alex McCowan** has staged St Marks Gospel as a one man show, word for word, in London and on Broadway, New York. The performance lasts just over ninty minutes. If you have a bible why not acquaint yourself with Mark's account of the teaching, life, death and resurrection of Jesus.
