The Grace of God

What this weekend's gospel stories have in common (the Shepherd & Lost Sheep & The Prodigal Son) is that both brought the lost home. Jesus is saying, this is what God is about and this is what I am about. He also seems to be saying that 'repentance', coming home, is much more about allowing ourselves to be found by a searching God than it is about anything we do ourselves. Yes, we have a role to play- the son staggered in the direction of home-however, our role is tiny in comparison to God's role. Our coming home to God, coming to our senses, is the work of God, above all; it is the work of grace. Our part consists of allowing God's grace to work in us.

St Paul was very aware of this from his own experience. In the second reading, he declares that he was the greatest of sinners because of all he had done to injure and discredit the faith. Yet he goes on to say, 'The grace of our Lord filled me with faith and with the love that is in Christ Jesus' God's searching love embraces those who are lost, calling on them to come in from the cold.
