# **Feast Days**

## Sept. 20<sup>th</sup> Andrew Kim Taegon (Companions (Korean Martyrs)

These martyrs died during the great persecution of 1839. They were canonized by Pope John Paul 11 in 1984 during his visit to Korea.

## Sept. 21<sup>st</sup> St Matthew

Matthew was a Jew and a Tax Collector when he called by Jesus to be one of the twelve apostles. It was shocking at the time for Jesus to call someone who was associated with 'sinners and tax collectors' to be one of his inner circle, an apostle.

# Sept. 23<sup>rd</sup> St Pio of Piatrelcina (Padre Pio)

While praying after Mass **Padre Pio** had a vision of Jesus and when it was over he had the stigmata on his hands feet and side, the year was 1918. In 1946 a **House for the Alleviation of Suffering** (hospital) was built and financed by **Padre Pio's** benefactors. He was canonized by Pope John Paul 11 in 2002.

### Be True To Oneself

We all want to protect the ones we love, just like **Peter** in the gospel. We want to protect children, to shield them, when they are small, from flames, large dogs, moving cars and strangers. When they get older, we're concerned that they be protected from the wrong company, from drug taking, from whatever dangers that go along with their idea of being all grown up when in reality they're only just leaving childhood.

We don't want loved ones to suffer. That's the most natural concern in the world.

Yet, we can't shield our loved ones from every challenge or difficulty, nor should we. **Jesus opted for integrity over ease, even over life itself.** 

Being a person of integrity will inevitably, at times involve some suffering. These are sufferings which are part and parcel of being a Christian, or simply being a person of integrity. To be shielded from such sufferings is to be tempted, like **Jesus** was by **Peter**, to take the easy way. Christians sometimes have to suffer for doing what is right.

The gospel today urges us to walk God's way not man's.
