St Patrick

In celebrating the **Feast of St Patrick**, we are celebrating the roots of our Christian faith on this island. We remember him as the great preacher of the gospel in our land. He has lit a flame that has remained for close on sixteen hundred years. We are very fortunate that two of Patrick's own writings have been preserved, his **Confessions** and a letter he wrote to the soldiers of a chieftain called **Coroticus**.

Patrick was brought to Ireland as a slave at 16 years of age. At 22 he managed to escape and make his way home to Wales. His parents thought he was dead. They were overjoyed to see him. Patrick states that **'they earnestly begged me that I should never leave them'**.

Some years later Patrick tells us he had a vision in which he heard the words 'We ask you, boy, come and walk once more among us.' Patrick answered the call and returned to Ireland after study and ordination.

Patrick's feast day invites us to trust that God can turn even our darkest experiences to good and can bring unexpected new life out of our loses in way that we might never have suspected at the time. Martin Hogan
