LENT 2018

Lent is a season when we try to take stock of ourselves. It is a time when the whole church is asked to go on a kind of **retreat**. When we think of a retreat, we tend to think of going away from the normal routine of life to a special place where there is a different routine.

In the gospel reading today we find Jesus doing just that. He is driven by the spirit into the desert. He remains there for forty days, which is the length of our Lenten season. For us, however, Lent is not a retreat in that sense. The arrival of Lent does not mean that the rhythm of our lives changes in any fundamental way. We cannot head out into the wilderness. We have to live Lent in the midst of life. Our Lenten retreat does not mean a retreat from life in the literal sense. What it does mean is that we try to become more self-reflective. Because we are asked to reflect on ourselves in the light of the gospel, it might be better to say that Lent is a time when we are called to become more prayerful. There are forces outside of us and deep within us that are hostile to the values of the gospel. The first step in overcoming them is to face them as Jesus did.

In prayer, we invite the Lord to show us those areas of our lives that are not in keeping with the call of the gospel and we ask the Lord to help us to change for the better where that is needed.
