Ministry of Encouragement

St Paul in his letters was fond of calling on the members of his churches to encourage one another in their faith. In today's first reading we find Paul, along with Barnabas, engaged in that same ministry of encouragement. The reading tells us that Paul and Barnabas 'put fresh heart into the disciples, encouraging them to persevere in the faith'.
