Feast Days Aug. 20th

St Bernard (1090-1153)

As **Abbot of Clairvaux** (France) Bernard was a very influencial figure in the Church in the twelfth century.

Very little is known of this apostle. In the New Testament, Bartholomew is only mentioned in the list of the apostles.

The artist painted Jesus and his friends around the supper table, but he also included all kinds of people around the table, showing people from many races. There were sick, lame and crippled men and women; young and old; beggers and misfits and some not very nice people. When the king saw the painting he went into a rage, "Of what is this a painting?" The artist said "Your highness, this is a painting of God who delights in all people; all saints and all sorts are welcome to the Kingdom and the earthly banquet... and that is my understanding of the Last Supper, Holy Communion and Eucharest."
