## **St Matthew**

Matthew is both an **Apostle** and an **Evangelist** (Gospel writer) He was a tax collector at the time he was called by **Jesus** to be one of the **Twelve**.

## Sept 23<sup>rd</sup> St Pius of Pietrelcina (Padre Pio)

In 1918 while making his thanksgiving after Mass, Padre Pio had a vision of Jesus and when it was over he had the stigmata on his hands feet and side. In 1946 a "House for the Alleviation of the sick", a 350 bed facility was opened financed by Padre Pio benefactors.
