But like every moment of ecstacy, time moves on. We have to return to the ordinary things of life. This is well expressed in the poem of Edwin Muir;

But the world rolled back into its place
And we are here. And all that radient kingdom lies forlorn.

The feast of **Corpus Christi** is a special opportunity for a transfiguration moment as we contemplate the presence of **Jesus** in the eucharest. But this sacred moment cannot last forever.
