"Lord open the door for us"

God gives us all the grace we need to be saved, and there is nothing we can do to earn or deserve it, but today's Gospel reminds us that simply being a Christian is no guarantee of salvation. We must guard against the assumption that we have a spot reserved for us in heaven by virtue of our familiarity with Jesus and his teachings.

The grace that God offers, while sufficient for our salvation, imposes responsibilities on us. Jesus does not say only a few will be saved, but that many will fail to make the necessary effort to do so. He tells us to "Strive to enter through the narrow gate" The word strive comes from the same Greek root as "agony" and refers to the effort given in an athletics competition. Jesus tells us that we must struggle for the prize, commit ourselves unconditionally to the faith.
