"Are you the one who is to come.....? We might find it easy to identify with the image of John the Baptist that we find in today' gospel. John is having a crisis of faith. From his prison cell he sends his disciples to ask Jesus "Are you the one who is to come, or have we got to wait for someone else?" John has a crisis of faith. It can happen to anyone.

Like John, we can discover that the Lord is not who we thought he was. Our expectation of him may not have come to pass. The image we had of the Lord no longer seems valid. What we were once certain about now leaves us full of questions. Like John, we suspect we might have got it wrong. Yet, such moments of uncertainity and doubt are inevitable on the journey of faith because we are always being called to grow in our relationship with the Lord. What satisfied us in our youth will not necessarily speak to us in the present and what satisfies us now may not serve us well in the future.

In one of the great beatitudes of the Gospels, **Jesus** declares blessed all those who keep faith in him, especially in those times when we begin to doubt everything and find ourselves asking **John's** question "*Are you the one who is to come...?* **County Choir**
