It is almost 100 years since **Pope Pius X1** set aside this day, called Mission Sunday so that every parish, diocese and religious community throughout the world would pray for and support missionaries and Christian communities in need. There have been tens of thousands of **Irish missionaries** who have given their lives happily in the service of the missions; they have brought education, health care anf the struggle for social justice to almost every country in the world. Some of them have been killed or lost their health and all of them have left the known and familiar to bring the story of **God's mercy**, the good news that is the gospel to some of the poorest people on the earth.

All funds collected on Mission Sunday are distributed to parishes in need in Third World countries. These are vetted and checked by the **Pontifical Mission Societies** in **Rome**. Last year the **Mission Sunday** collection for all of Ireland came to €1,3 million.
