Transfiguration

Can you recall a time when you had an 'aha moment'? One of those moments when something makes perfect sense to you. It may have been a long time coming, a combination of various pieces of the jigsaw fitting together or it may be an **insight** you received from prayer or spiritual practice. These are really special moments. We are never quite the same afterwards, something changes in us. These 'aha moments' are moments when 'the penny drops'. They are moments of transfiguration. This is what is happening to the disciples in today's gospel.: a very deep and significant experience.

Peter is desperate to stay on the mountain in that blissful moment with Jesus, so much so that he offers to build tents. One can understand Peter's request, after such an occurrence, it is natural that he would want to stay there, remain in the moment.

Do you recall a moment or an encounter where you simply did not want it to end? It may be something very deep and meaningful.

As with all blissful moments, the disciples must come down from the mountaintop. Jesus' way involves walking a very different path, a path that will not be so easy. Jesus' way is different to what Peter had in mind. No doubt these moments of transfiguration strengthen us all for walking the more difficult paths.
