#### **Human Freedom**

The parable in today's gospel features a narrow door and a locked door. As well it has a very unwelcoming doorman- its almost as if the master of the house wants to keep everyone out. People knock at the door and expect to be admitted, but it's not that simple. The master of the house turns them away, claiming not to know them despite protestations that they are acquainted.

In this story Jesus is trying to teach his listeners what it takes to be a follower. Jesus says that on the day of judgement there are going to be some surprises. People we never expected to meet in heaven will be there. Some who thought they had reserved seats will be turned away at the door.

Jesus is not saying these things to scare us. He is just reminding us that love of God and neighbor is a serious business. It includes a lot more than just keeping the rules and staying out of trouble. The door into heaven may be narrow, and sometimes it's a tight squeeze. But he is with us, always by our side, assuring us of his grace when we need it.
