# Prayer

In today's Gospel reading, **Jesus** speaks a parable about two people who went up to the temple to pray, one was a **Pharisee** (pillar of society) and a **tax collector** (commonly known as a sinner) The tax collector, for all his flaws and failings, did not get into the business of comparing himself with others in God's presence. He was content to look into his own heart only and he made no claim to know the hearts of others. It took him all his time to face the darkness in his own life, without speculating on what form of darkness might be in the lives of others. His prayer, '*God*, *be merciful to me a sinner*' was a genuine prayer. It came from the dept of his own truth. This parable encourages us to place our trust in God, more than in ourselves. It assures us that if we come before God empty handed, recognising our weaknesses, God's loving mercy towards us will know no bounds.
