A safeguarding Message from Bishop Francis Duffy

During the past year, since January 2018, 14 training events were organized in the diocese. In total, 216 people have attended. These included nine full training sessions, four updates as part of the annual deanery gatherings and specific training for various groups. Clergy, Local Safeguarding Representatives, those engaged in Parish Pastoral Ministry, Youth Choir Leaders, and Family Mass Assistants attended these sessions.

Safeguard training was also included as part of the preparation for the 29 Youth Helpers and the 34 Adult Helpers travelling on the Lourdes Pilgrimage.

In addition, over sixth people attended an information session on online safety as part of the diocesan Safeguarding Conference 2018 and over 80 people were present to hear **Teresa Devlin's** (CEO of the National Safeguarding Board for the Catholic Church in Ireland) address on "Safeguarding: an ongoing challenge and a vital ministry in the Church" on March 19th.

Bishop Francis end his message by saying-

"I thank our Parish Representatives who carry out their important work at local level to ensure standards are high and procedures are followed"
