Temperance Sunday

Temperance Sunday is celebrated on the Sunday before **Ash Wednesday.** What is temperance? This is what **The Catechism of the Catholic Church** has to say about temperance.

'Temperance is one of the 'cardinal' virtues along with prudence, justice and fortitude. Temperance is the virtue that moderates the attraction of pleasures and provides balance in the use of created things. It keeps desires within the limits of what is honourable. The temperate person directs the sensitive appetites towards what is good, and maintains a healthy direction. Temperance is often praised in the Old Testament: 'Do not follow your base desires, but restrain your appetites.' (Sir 18.30). In the New Testament it is called 'moderation' and 'sobriety'. 'We ought to live sober, upright and godly lives in this world' (Titus 2:12)
