Prodigal Son

There was once a judge in **New York City** who was notorious for his gentle treatment of criminals. His nick name was "*Cut 'em loose Bruce.*" He inspired a character on a TV show known as "*Let 'em go Joe*." He aroused great indignation on the part of the people who wanted strict justice. They could identify with the older brother in the parable of the **Prodigal Son.** Even the prodigal son himself agrees that he deserves to be treated harshly. He tells his father, "*I no longer deserve to be called your son*." But Jesus tells us that God is not like that. He not only takes the boy back but he throws a party.

God does not deny the reality of sin. He is not a sentimental old fool who closes his eyes to our shortcomings. He is saddened and indignant when he sees some of the things we do to one another. In this parable Jesus gives us an example of how to temper **justice** with **mercy**.

Let us pray today that God will give us a little bit of his great big heart. Ask for help to - hate the sin and love the sinner – to over-come the natural urge for vengeance and go for the supernatural virtue of forgiveness. *Fr James DiGiacomo, SJ.*
