Feast Days

Nov.30th

St Andrew (Apostle)

Andrew was St Peter's brother, and was called by Jesus. "As Jesus was walking by the Sea of Galilee, he saw two brothers, Simon who is now called Peter, and his brother Andrew, casting a net into the sea: they were fishermen" Legend now has it that Andrew preached the Good News in Greece and Turkey and that he was crucified at Patras.

A Jesuit, Francis was ordained in Venice in 1537. Francis ministered mostly in India, around Goa, where there is a sizeable Catholic population to this day.

Th Season of Advent

You may have noticed some changes in the church this weekend. A wreath with candles has appeared in the sanctuary. The colour of the vestments is now somber violet rather than green; the 'Glory to God in the highest' is omitted at the beginning of the Mass. The prayers and the readings of the Mass take on a certain character. We hear words like 'longing', 'waiting', 'preparing', 'promise', 'coming'. The short season of Advent has begun. It is a season that invites us to prepare for the feast of Christmas by focusing on what is really important in life.

In today's gospel we hear the Advent call to 'Watch', to 'Stay awake, praying at all times for the strength to stand with confidence before the Son of Man.' The call to watch is a call to pay attention to what is really important. For us as Christians, what is ultimately important is our relationship with the Lord. That relationship is the foundation of all our other relationships. Advent invites us to pay attention to that most important of relationships. The great prayer of Advent is 'Come Lord Jesus' In Advent we invite the Lord to come into our lives more fully.
