Passion of St John the Baptist

As pope he refered to himself as "the servant of the servants of Christ". He died in 604.

Invitation

As we reflect on this weekend's gospel reading, we usually focus on **Jesus**' parable teaching us not to look for places of honour, nor to place ourselves before others. However let us look at a simple word repeated at least **ten times** in this short passage: "*invite*." Whom do we invite to our table. Whom does **Jesus** invite to his eucharistic table?

To invite means to offer an opportunity of beginning a friendship, of calling another person to share his or her life, talents, time with us.

To be invited means to accept the gift of another, not to be in control of what happens or of what is served or of who else may be present. It implies surrendering our way of doing things and the acceptance of what the other person offers. An invitation is left open to the choice of the person invited, who can accept or reject it.

Jesus invites us to his eucharistic table. Remember he invites "the poor, the crippled, the lame, the blind." We are counted among these chosen ones and we can accept or reject the invitation.
