The gospel reading this weekend suggests that we are to be people of clear vision. Jesus asks "Can one blind man lead another? Surely both will fall into a pit" We need to attend to the splinter or indeed, the plank in our own eye before we can lead others anywhere. We need to be open to the likelihood that we have significant blind spots that inhibit us doing the Lord's work. In other words, a certain healthy self-criticism is needed if we are to relate in a life - giving way to others

We are all aware of a tendency in ourselves at times to be over critical of others while failing to acknowledge our own failings. The business of trying to take the splinter out of someone else's eye while failing to notice the plank in our own is more than a humorous image. Jesus tells us to be more preoccupied with the plank in our own eye than with the splinter in the eye of our neighbor.
