Corpus Christi (Body of Christ)

On this feast of **Corpus Christi** we celebrate the gift of the Eucharist. It was one of the last actions of Jesus to give this nourishment for our life's journey.

The Eucharist as Pope Francis says "**is not a prize for the perfect but a powerful medicine and nourishment for the weak**".

It is a call for all of us to grow and to share with one another Christ's message of **love and peace**. The Eucharist sustains us on this Christian path and brings us together as brothers and sisters travelling together on this journey of faith.

From the earliest days the followers of Jesus gathered on the Sabbath Day to sing or recite the psalms, to tell and read stories from the Old Testament and, most importantly to tell stories and events from the life of Jesus. Then they said the prayer of blessing over the bread and wine and shared the consecrated bread and wine among themselves., knowing that the risen Jesus was as present then as he was on the night of the last supper.

Our celebration of the **Eucharist** (Mass) today follows the very same pattern as it did in the earliest days of the church.
