## The Harvest is Rich

**Jesus'** words about a great harvest and the need for many labourers are often interpreted as referring to the need to pray for an increase in vocations to the priesthood and religious life. Though priests and religious are among the labourers that are needed in the Lord's harvest, these words have a much broader reference. The Lord needs all kind of labourers in his harvest. We are all called to be labourers in the Lord's harvest by virtue of our baptism.

Jesus is saying that there is enormous scope to bring the gospel of God's kingdom to people; the task is enormous and the need is great. All the followers of Jesus are needed for this work. It is not the prerogative of a select few. There has been a decline in the number of people going on for priesthood and religious life. It is not clear that this trend will be reversed anytime soon, at least in the western world. In the mean time, the harvest remains great and many, many labourers are needed. The whole Church has a role to play in bringing the Gospel to others. Different people will do this in different ways, depending on their gifts and on the circumstances of their daily lives. Jesus wants to work through us all; he has a role for each one of us in his great work.
