Sept 8th Birth of Mary

The church has celebrated the birth of Mary since at least the sixth century. Scripture does not give an account of Mary's birth. The September 8th date helped determine the date for the feast of the Immaculate Conception on **December 8th** (nine months later).

Born in **512** he came to **Clonmacnois** in 545 where he founded a monastery which was to become one of the most renown in Europe. He died at the age of **33** while the monastery was being built.
