Advent

Today we begin the short season of **Advent.** We light the first candle on our **Advent wreath**. As the days continue to grow darker, the growing light of our **Advent wreath** over the next three Sundays proclaims that as a faith community we are drawing nearer to the celebration of that great feast of God's light, the feast of **Christmas.**

By the time we get to **Christmas** day, the days will begun to get imperceptibly longer and our celebration of **Christs** birth will coincide with the reemergence of light within nature. In that sense, the lighting of our first **Advent** candle is full of promise, as we look ahead in hope to the coming of **God's** light in **Christ** and in nature.

In today's Gospel, **Jesus** says we are "to stay awake" Being awake to what **God** wants will often mean leaving behind ways and paterns that are not part of God's future. **Paul** mentions drunken orgies, promiscuity, wrangling and jealousy. We can make our own list, probably a much less spectacular or colourful one than Paul's.

Advent calls on us to be alert to everything within us and among us that can have no place in God's future.
