When Jesus was Small

In primary school we used to sing a song about Jesus' childhood. The chorus went something like this:

The aim was clearly to remind us that Jesus was a real child who did all the things that other children do. These verses impressed on our young minds the **humanity** of Jesus, even as we heard the stories of the healings and the miracles that expressed his **divinity**

But the story ends with the realization that Jesus is far from ordinary. His parents don't understand his cryptic reference to 'My father's affairs', but Mary stores up all these things in her heart, accepting the mysterious workings of God. Second man was Colin Griffin, Ballinamore AC (London Olympian 2012 in 50km walk). The winner of the women's race was Catherina McKiernan, Ireland's greatest woman long distant runner.
