July 1<sup>st</sup>

St Oliver Plunkett

*He martyred on July 1<sup>st</sup> 1681 at Tyburn (London), by hanging, disemboweling, quartering and beheading. He was the first of the Irish martyrs to be beatified. His head is in St Peter's Church, Drogheda.*

July 3<sup>rd</sup>

St Thomas

*Doubting Thomas made what is the most explicit statement of faith in the New Testament: "My Lord and My God"*

July 4<sup>th</sup>

St Elizabeth of Portugal (1271-1336)

*After the death of her husband, Denis, king of Portugal, she entered the Poor Clare convent at Coimbra, Portugal.*

July 6<sup>th</sup>

St Maria Goretti (1891-1902)

*Died a martyr at the age of 12 while resisting a sexual assault.*

## The Spirit of the Lord

In some ways we can be like **James** and **John** in the gospel this weekend. In **Galilee** they left their nets to set out on a journey to follow **Jesus**. They took the path that the spirit prompted them to take. Yet, along the way they sometimes allowed a very different kind of spirit to influence them.

In this weekend's gospel they wanted to call fire down from heaven to destroy the **Samaritans** who refused them hospitality. Such a violent response to the experience of rejection was not that of the Spirit, and **Jesus** rebuked them.

We too have set out on a journey as followers of **Jesus**. Yet, like **James** and **John**, we can act and speak in a way that is inconsistent with the path we have chosen. When that happens, as inevitably it will, we invite the Spirit of the Lord to come upon us anew and to **redirect our steps**.

With the **Spirits** help, we once more set our face to go where the Lord is calling us to go.
