The story of the Transfiguration is read on the second Sunday of Lent each year. Tradition, names **Mount Tabor** as the site of this vision of the risen Lord experienced by **Peter, James and John**.

Aug. 8th St Teresa Benedicta of the Cross (Edith Stein) Edith Stein was born into a Jewish but stopped believing in God when she was 14. Having read the autobiography of **St Teresa of Avila** she began a spiritual journey that led to her baptism and later a **Carmelite sister**. She died in the gas chambers of **Auschwitz** on August 9th 1942.She was canonized by **Pope John Paul 11** in 1998.

Wisely, Jesus does not get involved in this family dispute. Instead he uses the opportunity to warn against the dangers of greed.

Greed is the desire to acquire more than we need or is good for us. When we give in to greed we usually do damage not only to ourselves but others as well. Parents usually tell their children not to be greedy when they see them taking more than they need thereby depriving others. However, greed is more an adult issue than a childhood one.

The question that matters at the end of our lives is not 'What do I possess?' or 'What have I achieved?' but 'Who have I become?'
