Christ Our Light

'A light shines in the darkness, a light that darkness could

not overpower.' A statement from today's gospel that is full of hope. We have all known our dark times. A darkness of mind can also come over us; we find it hard to think clearly; we struggle to find a clear way forward out of some complex situation.
