#### Leo the Great (died 461)

Elected Pope in **440**, **Leo** went on to be one of the best administrative Popes of the early Church. He is also known for his spiritually profound sermons.

## Nov 11<sup>th</sup> St Martin of Tours (316-397)

Martin was bishop of **Tours** (France). It was the people of the diocese that demanded he be their bishop. He is the patron saint of **France**.

## Nov 15<sup>th</sup> Albert the Great (1206-1280)

He was the eldest son of a powerful and wealthy **German** family. Despite fierce family opposition, he ertered the **Dominican** order.

## **Sowing the Seed**

I recall the story of an important government leader, not from recent times but from the past. He was an atheist who had no religious direction but, as a child, he had heard his grandmother pray and her words remained in his heart, At a very difficult time in his life, he recalled this; 'My grandmother used to pray.' And so he began to recite the same words that his grandmother had used, and he found faith. Prayers, even small prayers, sow life. That is why it is so important to teach children to pray. I suffer when I encounter children who do not know how to make the sign of the cross. They have to be taught to make the sign of the cross properly, because it is the first prayer. Then perhaps over time they will forget or take another path, but the first prayers a child learns remain in the heart, because they are a seed of life, the seed of dialogue with God.
